ADMISSION NOTICE

Online applications are invited from the desirous candidates for seeking admission in Government/Private ITIs of UT of J&K, for the academic session 2022-23-24 in various Engineering/Non-Engineering trades having duration of two years/one year/six months being run under NCVT/SCVT scheme and commencing from September, 2022 for which the forms can be uploaded from **18th of June, 2022.**

Candidates having minimum age of 14 years as on 1st June 2022, with no upper age bar (except Driver Cum Mechanic (LMV) trade for which minimum age is 18 years) can apply. The desirous candidates have to fill up the admission forms online available at ITI admission like (<http://itiadmissions.jkdsd.in>) present on the official website of Directorate of Skill Development (erstwhile Technical Education) J&K i.e. www.jkdsd.org.

The last date for applying online is up-to **9th of July, 2022.** The details pertaining to the trades functioning in various Government /Private ITIs for which admissions are to be made for the session 2022-23-24 for free and self financing seats are available in the portal and can also be sought from the concerned ITIs.


The candidates have to fill up the complete details which include basic details of the student like name, parentage, qualification etc online in the portal and have to upload the soft copy of the following documents online only:-

1. Marks Certificate of qualifying examination.
2. Date of Birth Certificate.
3. Category Certificate (SC/ST/Ex-serviceman/EWS/Physically Handicapped) if any.
4. Aadhaar Card.
5. Domicile Certificate should be produced at the time of admission in the respective ITI.

The candidates after finalizing the profile and application online will be required to deposit the print out of the system generated application in the concerned ITI in which the candidate is applying along with self attested Photo copies of above mentioned required documents in the concerned institute. The detailed guidelines for verifying the application forms by the ITIs will be issued separately to the institutes.

The candidate has to pay a fee of Rs.100/ (one hundred) per three trades in which he/she is seeking admission against cash receipt from respective ITI.

The detailed guideline for filling the application forms by the candidates is also available on ITI admission portal. In case of any technical issues kindly mail on help me itcell.jkdsd@gmail.com.



Important Note:

- Selection will be made purely on the basis of academic merit obtained by the applicants in their qualifying examination (both for free and self financing seats separately).
- On successful completion of training in trades running under NCVT/SCVT scheme, certificate will be awarded by National/ State Council for Vocational Training.
- Candidates who have already undergone training in any of the trades in any ITI can apply for admissions in another trade after two years of completion of previous training course, however, for the ensuing academic session, their admission can be considered in any trade having poor response.

Important Instructions: The ITIs are advised to take proactive steps for addressing information asymmetry in filling available trades/seats through various measures such as the following:

- Advertise through local media, hoardings at prominent places, posters and banner at secondary schools about the available training options available in each district.
- Encourage Chief Education Officer and Principals of secondary schools to approach the students and parents for encouraging them seeking admission in ITIs.
- Provide appropriate counselling and guidance to the drop outs as well as prospective trainees about the career prospects after ITI training.
- Coordinate with gram panchayats and local bodies for running a mobilization campaign for admission.
- Publicise through local channels, radios, print media and brochures.
- District Skill Committee may also be involved to take measures on broadening the prospective of ITIs in their districts.
