ADMISSION NOTICE

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for seeking admission in Government/Private ITIs of UTJK for the academic session **2025-26/27** in various Engineering/Non- Engineering trades having duration of two years/one year/six months being run under NCVT/SCVT schemes with effect from **15th May, 2025 to 30th May, 2025**. The forms can be uploaded from **15th May, 2025**. The Academic session shall start from 1st September, 2025.

Candidates having minimum age of 14 years as on **1st September 2025**, with no upper age bar (except Driver Cum Mechanic (LMV) trade) for which minimum age is 18 years) can apply. The desirous candidates have to fill up the admission forms online available at ITI admission portal viz. (<https://itiadmissions.jkdsd.in>) link is also present on the official website of Directorate of Skill Development, J&K i.e. www.jkdsd.in

The details of trades functioning in various Government/Private ITIs for which admissions are to be made for the session 2025-26/27 under normal and self financing schemes are available on the portal and can also be sought from the concerned ITIs.

The candidates have to fill up the complete details like name, parentage, qualification etc online in the portal and have to upload the following documents on the portal:-

- I. Marks Certificate of qualifying examination.
- II. Date of Birth Certificate.
- III. Category Certificate (SC / ST / Ex-serviceman / OBC / EWS / Physically Handicapped) if any.
- IV. Aadhaar Card.
- V. Domicile Certificate should be produced at the time of admission in the respective ITI.

The candidates after finalizing the profile and application online will be required to deposit the print out of the system generated application in the concerned ITI in which the candidate is applying along with self attested photo copies of above mentioned required documents in the respective institutes.

The candidate has to pay a fee of Rs.100/- (one hundred) per three trades in which he/she is seeking admission against cash receipt from respective ITI.

The detailed guideline for filling the application forms by the candidates is also available on ITI admission portal. In case of any technical issues kindly mail at itcell.jkdsd@gmail.com.

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Important Note:

- Selection will be made purely on the basis of academic merit obtained by the applicant in their qualifying examination (both for free and self financing seats separately).
- On successful completion of training in trades running under NCVT/SCVT scheme, certificate will be awarded by National/State Council for Vocational Training.
- Candidates who have already undergone training in any of the trades in any ITI can apply for admissions in another trade after two years of completion of previous training course. However, for the ensuing academic session, their admission can be considered in any trade having less response.
- Selected Candidates should retain a consistent mobile number and e-mail address, till completion of course, untill certification, as changes are not permitted by DGT.

Outreach efforts:

The ITIs are advised to take proactive steps for addressing information asymmetry in filling available trades/seats through various measures such as the following:

- Advertisement via TV, Radio, Print Media and brochures Social networking, hoardings at prominent places, posters and banner at Secondary Schools about the available training options in each district.
- Chief Education Officer and Principals of Secondary Schools be approached for encouraging the students and parents for seeking admission in ITIs for skill courses.
- Provide appropriate counseling and guidance to the drop outs as well as prospective trainees about the career prospects after ITI training.
- Coordinate with Gram Panchayats and local bodies for running a mobilization campaign for admission.
- District Skill Committee may also be involved to take measures on broadening the prospective of ITIs in their districts.
